

SOCIAL PLAY GUIDELINES.

Healesville Tennis Club Inc. tennis activities are conducted under certain rules and guidelines, to comply by the Club's constitution, by-laws and safety regulations.

The following conditions apply for persons organizing and running Social tennis programs.

- Everyone who participates should have the opportunity to play against players of comparable standard.
- The Convenor should keep a list of names of all players participating.
- Players who play more than 3 times are expected to become Full or Social members of the Healesville Tennis Club.
- Fees to cover the cost of balls and lighting need to be paid at each day/night session.
- The cost is \$2 for full members and \$4 for social members and players who have played less than 3 matches. The club will supply second hand balls. Money collected to be passed on to the Treasurer.
- The Convenor is responsible for calling a washout, and informing the regular players if possible.
- The Co-ordinator needs to be a Full member of the Club and will be given an Executive key to open the courts etc.
- At the conclusion of play all lights need to be turned off, and all gates and doors locked. The Club rooms should be left in a clean state.
