Your email address is your key to accessing tennis online

Each member must have their own unique email address to login and that same email cannot be allocated to another member's account.

However children under 15 years are able to use their parent/guardian's email address and then login with a username instead of an email. Family memberships are able to have the one email address.

Date of birth (DOB) is a mandatory field

Why does Tennis Australia (TA) need our DOB?

TA uses DOB to negotiate insurance cover on our behalf, develop, run, and administer existing and new competitions, programs, activities and other events to increase the participation of tennis. For example, cardio tennis, hot-shots, young mum's programs, senior participation programs, free tennis days.

Tennis Court Keys: \$30

A key is available to members, excluding Social Members and comes with the following conditions of use:

- Allows access HTC courts at both Queen's Park and Don Road when they are not being used for Club Competitions or social matches
- Keys are not transferable and are not to be lent to anyone
- Members may invite a non-member to play tennis at HTC's courts three times, thereafter; the invited guest must become a member
- The key holder is responsible for the conduct of the invited guest
- Courts must be maintained when using the key to access courts for personal use
- Junior members are entitled to hold a key under the supervision of a parent
- On surrendering of membership, the key must be returned to the Treasurer and a \$10 refund will be paid
- Loss of a key must be reported immediately to the Treasurer and will incur a loss of refund and \$30 for a replacement key
- Ensure courts are locked at the end of play.

Friends of Healesville Tennis Club

Perfect for casual users, parents/guardians and friends who wish to have a social connection with the Club and receive relevant communication.

Covers players with player accident insurance for casual court hire.

Court hire remains at the standard non-member fee. (\$15 per hour)

Working Bees

Player, Parent/Guardian Code of Behaviour
