COVID-19 Update

Our tennis has again been disrupted by another lockdown.

Its now time to get back on the courts, but with some considerations:

As of 11.59pm Thursday 17th June, 2021

- Competitions, tournaments, and training is permitted for all ages. Limited to the minimum number of people required to participate in and facilitate the activity (players, coaches, and parent/guardian for supervision purposes).
- Clubhouses can open subject to a density quotient of 1 person per 4sqm.
- Maximum group coaching sizes of 20 outdoors.
- Face coverings are to be carried at all times and worn indoors except if a medical exception applies. They can be removed when participating.
- Spectators are **not** allowed (excludes people necessary to facilitate the activity such as coaches, trainers, umpires, carers, parents and guardians).

It is with great sadness that we say good-bye to Wal.

Wal passed away peacefully at the Holmwood Aged Care facility on Friday 23rd April, after a long and frustrating battle with cancer.

He was a valued and respected member of the Healesville Tennis Club for 33years, having moved with his wife, Teresa, to Healesville in the 1988.

When the Blackmars migrated from England, he continued his trade as a toolmaker at the Vulcan factory in Bayswater.
