- Fundraising

- Show respect to officials and supervisors.

Breaches of this code of behaviour may result in the loss of your current HTC membership and denial of future membership applications.

### Book a Court

The Healesville Tennis Courts are available for casual use by both members and non-members.

- Access to the courts will be through the Book a Court platform via the HTC Website.
- Court vacancies will be visible to enable you to book a court that does not clash with other users.
- The gate system will be open for the period that a booking is made, and a short period of time on either side of this, otherwise, the gate system will be locked.
- Each member will need to register into the system to enable a specific PIN to be allocated.
- This PIN will be your entry code ongoing – but you still need to book a court through the Book a Court system to enable the PIN to be activated for every period of time that you wish to play on the courts outside of HTC play options.
- Pricing:

Non-Member Casual Users - \$20 per hour
- Ensure that the Gate is closed at end of play.
